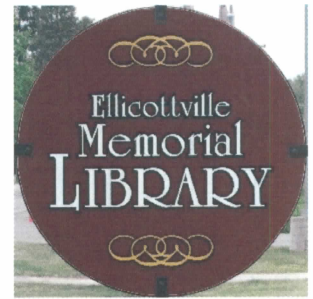


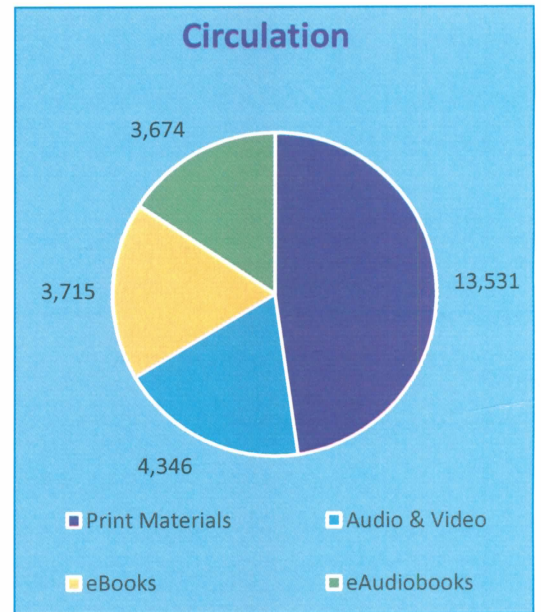

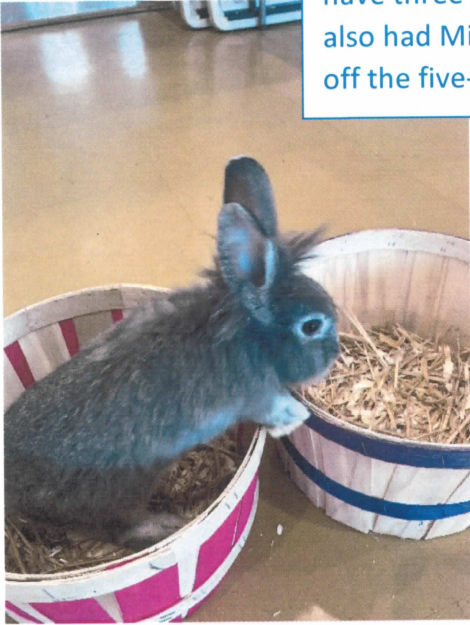

Our Summer Reading Program was a big success. A total of 96 children and 12 adults registered for the program which followed the national theme of "Color Our World". Through the Elisa B. Hughey Foundation we were able to have three art presentations by a local art student. We also had Mike Morton and his outdoor petting zoo to kick off the five-week program.



This past year, the library was once again a very busy place. We held 882 programs with 6,287 people in attendance. We circulated more than 25,000 items and over 23,000 patrons came through our doors!



This was the fourth year for our "Escape the Haunted Library" event. There were 51 people on ten teams that participated. Teams were locked in the library and had thirty minutes to find the clues and solve the riddles in order to escape.
